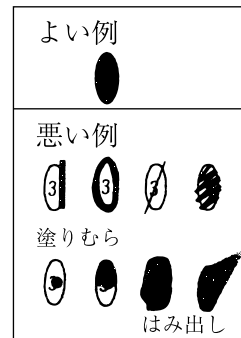

## マークのしかた

- マークは楕円内をむらなく塗りつぶすこと。
- HBの鉛筆または同じ濃さのシャープペンシルで塗りつぶすこと。
- 一度塗りつぶしたものを直すときは、あとが残らないように、プラスチック製消しゴムできれいに消してから直すこと。

Mother: Oh, really? I wanted to go there, too. How were the \*cherry blossoms?

Keiko: They were \*at their best. ( 1 ) I think the cherry blossoms in Hirosaki Park are the most beautiful in Japan.

Mother: That's right. Were there many people who came to see them in the park?

Keiko: Yes, there were. ( 2 ) There were many foreign people, too.

Mother: I'm happy to hear that. \*I'm very proud of the cherry blossoms in Hirosaki Park.

Keiko: \*So am I. ( 3 ) We have old \*historic temples and shrines, Western-style buildings, Mt. Iwaki and so on. I would like to \*introduce them to many people not only from Japan but also from other countries.

Mother: That sounds interesting. ( 4 )

Keiko: I know that. You know, my favorite subject is English. Speaking English is fun for me. I'm going to go to university to study English. And I want to \*study abroad in the future.

Mother: Your dream is so great! ( 5 )

Keiko: Thank you, Mother. I will \*do my best.

4 次の英文を読んで後に続く問に答えなさい。(46点)

Sam was a \*lawyer in New York. He had a son, but his son \*died in a car accident twenty years ago, so he was very \*lonely. He had a dog ① (call) Henry. Henry was very sick because he was very old and had a \*tumor in his head. Henry was becoming \*paralyzed by the tumor. He could not walk \*anymore with his four legs, so he was \*lying in the \*backyard all the time.

Sam looked for an animal doctor who could save his dog, and went out to the town every day, but he could not find a good doctor. He did not know \*what to do. So, Sam went to a doctor who took care of him. Sam said, "Please help my dog, Henry. He is dying because of a tumor." The doctor said, "I am not an animal doctor. I can't take care of a dog. (あ) There are so many people who are sick and waiting for me." But, Sam didn't give up. He \*continued to ask the doctor to help the dog, and \*finally the doctor agreed to help Henry, but he was \*not sure if he could save Henry.

Two weeks later, Sam went to the hospital with Henry to have an \*operation. There he met Jim. He was a five-year-old boy and had tumors in his head. He had no family to help him with money. Jim was going to die because he had no money. (い) [the poor boy / asked / to / Sam / help / the doctor].

Sam ② (feel) very sorry and decided to help Jim, but then he had no money to save his dog because Sam had to \*spend all of his money on Jim's operation. Jim had an operation with Sam's help. His operation was a \*success.

Sam was very happy for Jim, but now he was very sad because his dog was in a very bad \*condition. When he \*sadly walked out the gate of the hospital with his dog, the doctor came to Sam and said, "Thank you for helping Jim. Now, I will see your dog, Henry. Come back to the waiting room. I will \*do my best to save him." Sam was very ( A ).

The operation on Henry was also a success. The doctor did the operation \*for free. Sam was very happy. During the operation, Sam talked with Jim, and Jim said he wanted to have a dog like Henry. Sam remembered his son who died twenty years ago and he thought that he wanted to have a son like Jim. After the operation, Sam decided to \*adopt Jim. Jim and Sam lived happily together with Henry. One day Sam said to Jim, "We are all \*connected, you see. \*Like I am connected to you, you are connected to someone. We live for \*those who are connected to us. We are all \*affected by the people around us."
